I offer this letter in support of applications currently before the CRTC by All Points Bulletin TV and Avis de Recherche TV. We live in a complex and very sophisticated world where those involved in crime utilize every possible technological opportunity to advance their criminal enterprise. It is imperative that all law abiding Canadians have access to the most up to date information on crime by any number of sources available.

Our role is to collectively work together in order to detect, interdict and prevent crime. Fewer crimes relates directly to having fewer victims. Information in the public domain can also lead to the apprehension of those who inflict their criminal behaviour upon others.
